



Parents/Guardians: Know Your Rights

You have the right to:

Know that the school system is requiring all schools to provide information to you through letters and meetings. Individual conferences may be arranged by your request.

Be informed about all program options offered in the system.

Be informed about the materials used in the program options offered in the District.

Select an Alternative Bilingual Program for your son/daughter.

Move your child into an English-Language Mainstream Class at the beginning of the school year or the end of the first semester.

We urge you to exercise your rights in making an informed decision regarding your child's educational program.

If for any reason you feel our District has not followed these procedures or you are not satisfied with your child's placement, please feel free to call your child's principal, or the English Language Learners (ELL)/Sheltered English Immersion Program (SEIP) office, at extension 6096.
